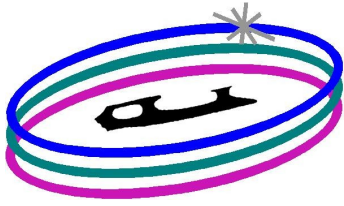

## **Learn to Skate Class**

Each week your class includes group instruction and practice ice.



**Academy Classes** are designed for the beginning skater to learn the basics and more experienced skaters to achieve greater proficiency. Classes are divided by age and ability and tests levels are achieved in sequential order. Skaters are encouraged to progress at their own pace and may move up levels at any time during a session when all skills in a given level are mastered.

Classes are taught by experienced, professional skating instructors. Class sizes are small so each skater receives personalized attention. Academy professionals are also available for private instruction.

**Snowplow Sam:** Ages 3-5; Skaters learn to fall down properly, stand, march and other basics of skating. (Helmet required; bicycle or hockey helmets are acceptable.)

**Basic 1-8:** Ages 6+; Skaters learn forward skating, backward crossovers, stopping and turning.

**Freestyle 1-6:** Upon completion of Basic 1-8, skaters are introduced to more advanced jumps, spins, and footwork.

**Adult 1-4:** USFS offers beginner and advanced adult skaters a program that introduces footwork, stopping, and freestyle elements.
